DATA AND REFERENCES USED IN EIA STUDIES

Kindly be informed of the following requirements:

- In conducting EIA studies, consultants may use primary data and secondary data (depending on needs). Samples collected shall be analyzed only by SAMM Accredited Lab. In presenting any primary data in the report, please include details of the sampling including the person in charge, time, date and location of samples. (Note : for details, please refer to EIA Induction Course Notes);
- For secondary data, any data, map and references used in all EIA studies shall only be extracted from verified, legitimate or authorized sources (e.g from the relevant government agencies such as Jabatan Ukur dan Pemetaan Malaysia, Jabatan Mineral dan Geosains, Jabatan Pertanian etc). Source of information as well as the date of the publication must be clearly stated in the report.
- Secondary data obtained from other sources can be used as additional/ supporting information or for comparison purpose (if relevant). Source of information as well as the date of the publication must be clearly stated in the EIA report.
