



NEW SMOKE EMISSION LIMIT FOR **DIESEL VEHICLES** ENTERING SINGAPORE



WHAT CAUSES BLACK SMOKE EMISSION?



National Environment Agency (NEA) of Singapore has issued early notification that the emission limit for diesel vehicles will be tightened **from 50 HSU to 40 HSU effective 1st July 2014**. The new emission limit is applicable to all diesel vehicles entering Singapore.

All diesel vehicle owners are required to take necessary steps to ensure compliance to this new emission limit set by NEA Singapore.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF VEHICLE OWNER OR DRIVER

Owners or drivers of diesel vehicles should implement the following steps:

- Adhere to recommended maintenance schedule.
- Periodic smoke inspection.
- Service the fuel injector for every 20,000 km.
- Service the fuel pump for every 20,000 km.
- Engine overhaul for every 100,000 km.
