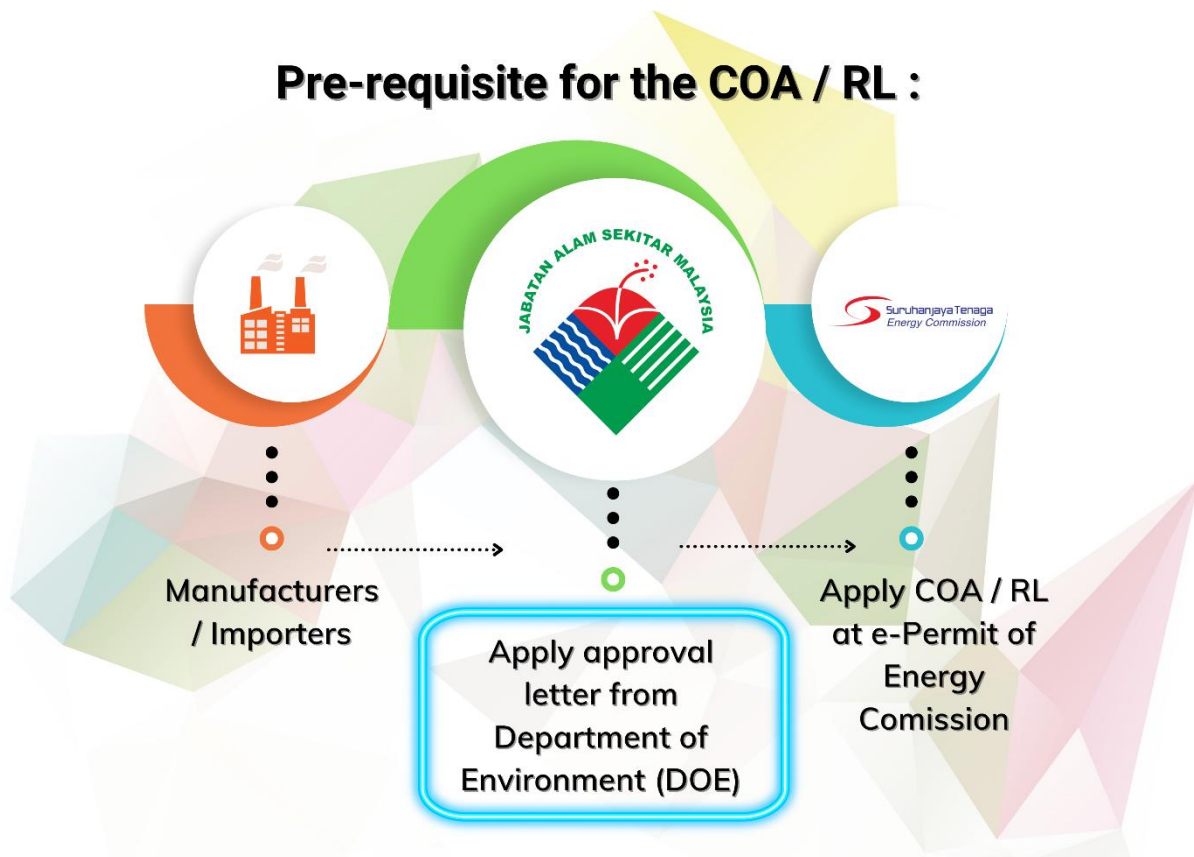


NEW PROCEDURES FOR THE CONTROL OF IMPORTATION AND PRODUCTION OF REFRIGERATION AND AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT

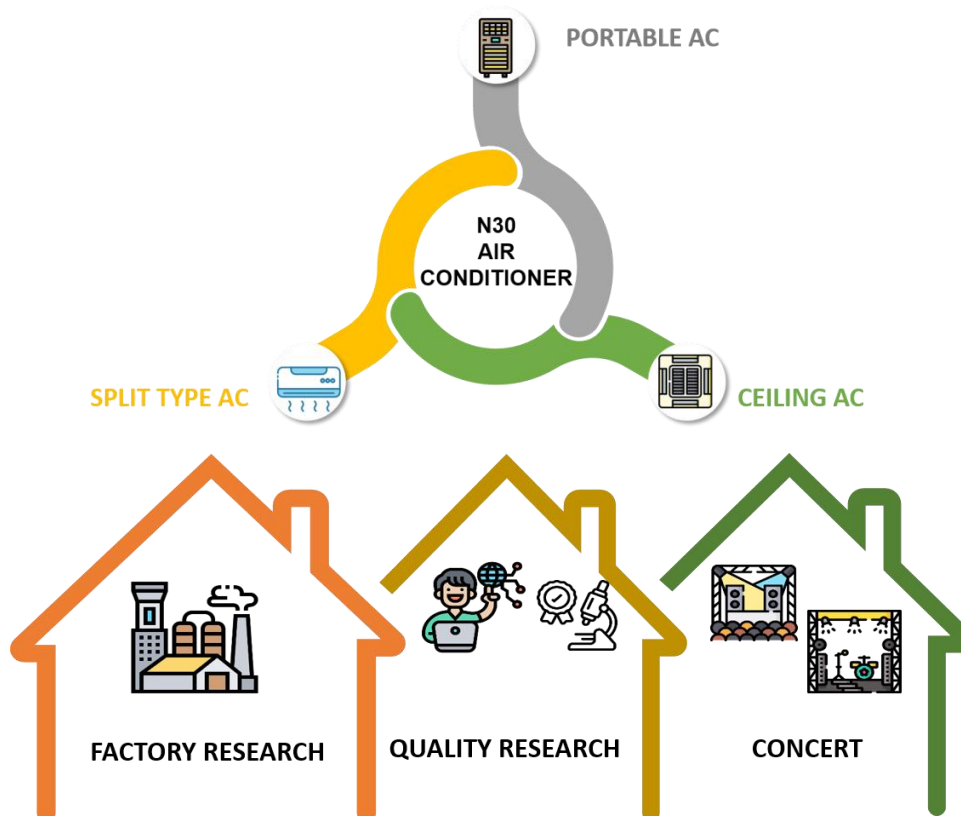
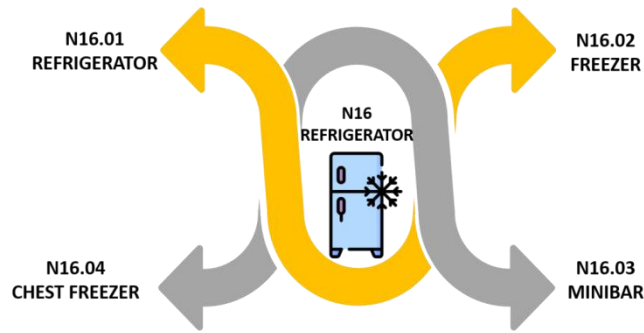
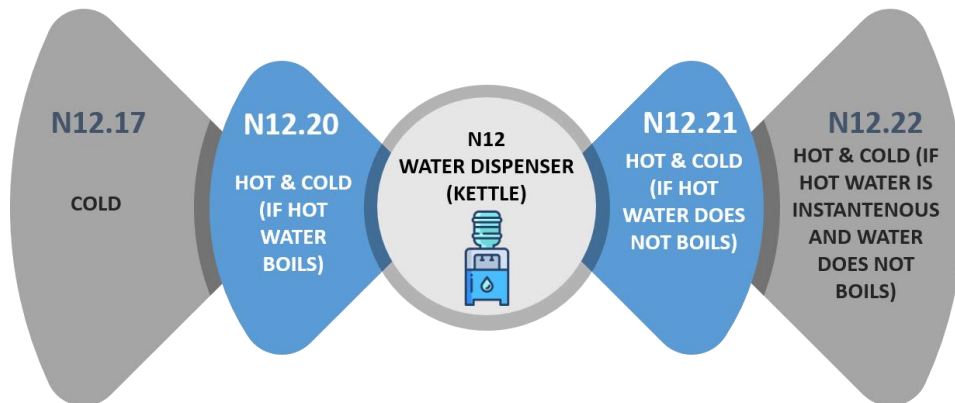
In line with the obligations under the Montreal Protocol, the Government has agreed to control the importation, production and installation of refrigerators and air conditioners using HCFCs. The regulation to manage the refrigerants is the Environmental Quality (Refrigerant Management) Regulations 2020, HCFCs are listed in the Second Schedule as control substances that are harmful to the environment. The regulation also states a ban on the manufacture or installation of any HCFC-based air conditioning equipment for use in Malaysia. This new procedures will come into force on 1 December 2022.

DOE Approval Letter

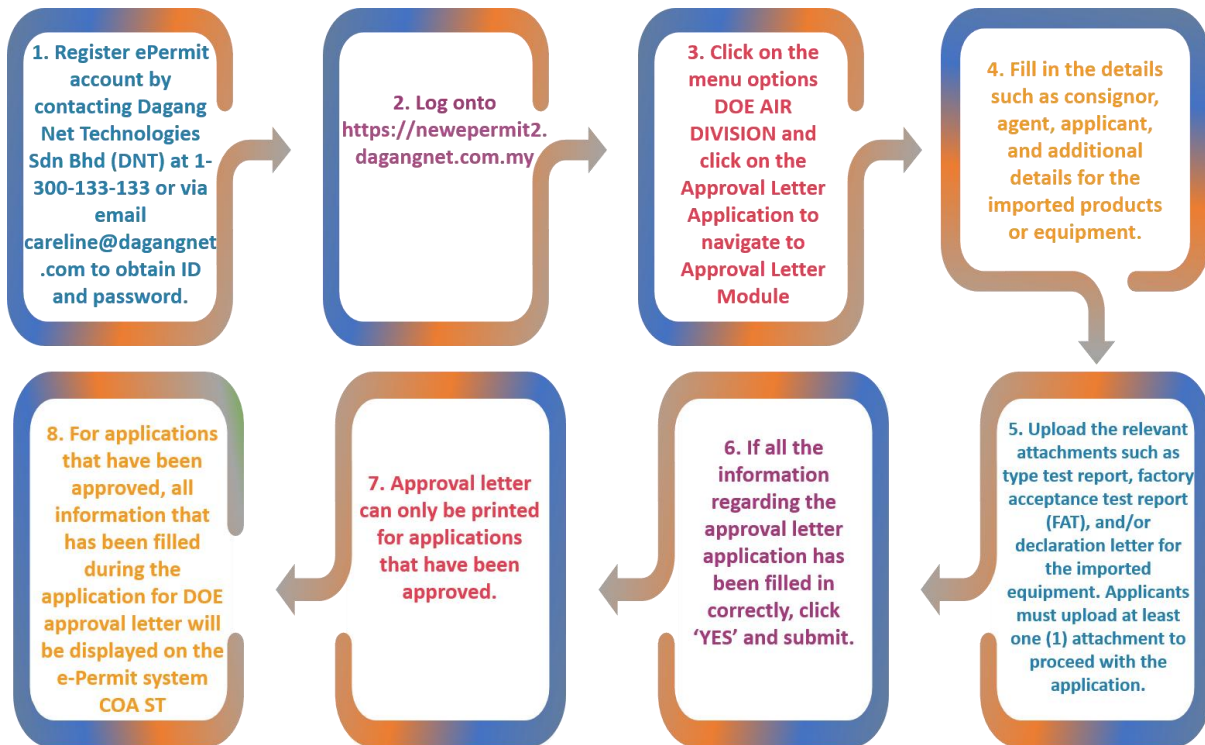
DOE Approval Letter is pre-requisite before any manufacturer/importer of refrigeration and air-conditioning product applies for a Certificate of Approval (COA) or Release Letter (RL) from the Energy of Commission.
